

COVID-19 Vaccine Opportunities on Campus



CDC now recommends booster shots at 5 months after the completion of the primary series of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for those aged 16 and older, [see media statement](#)

The Health Center will be offering **first, second, and booster doses of the Pfizer COVID vaccine** to eligible **students on most Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 2pm-4:30pm in the Student Health Center (not on the following dates: Thursday February 17, Tuesday March 8, Thursday March 10, March 15, or Thursday March 17)**. To schedule a COVID vaccine on campus in the Health Center, students can schedule online in the patient portal <https://carrollu.medicatconnect.com/> by choosing COVID-19 vaccine as the reason code or call 262-524-7233.

Anyone who is 16 or older is eligible to receive a COVID vaccine booster if it has been 5 months or more from the date of your last/second Pfizer vaccine, 6 months or more from your last/second Moderna vaccine, or 2 months from your J&J vaccine. **To avoid having to quarantine for 5 days if you are exposed to COVID, under the new guidelines, you will need to get your COVID booster when you are eligible.**

If you have received the COVID vaccine or a booster dose, log into the Mediat patient portal <https://carrollu.medicatconnect.com/> and upload a copy of your COVID-19 vaccination card under the upload tab so that the information can be verified.
