## Theatre History

In Theatre History and Literature I, the traditions of the Euro-American theatre are investigated in terms of theatre conventions and drama of the various periods. In Theatre History and Literature II, Concentration upon North American and European drama, Asian, Latin American and African theatre conventions and drama are presented. Prerequisite: THE 101 or consent of instructor. Bonus: these courses count towards the Fine Arts GE2 and CCD requirements.
