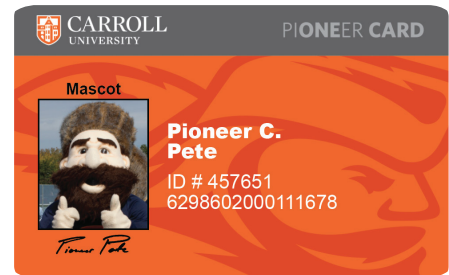
Your PiONEer Card is your official campus identification card and can be used in several ways:
