



All newly admitted and readmitted undergraduate students are required to provide proof of certain immunizations. Prior to arrival on campus, all new and readmitted students will complete this information on the required Health History Form and return it to the Student Health Center. Two doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccine are required. The first MMR must have been given no earlier than 4 days before the first birthday. The 2nd dose of MMR vaccine must have been administered at least 28 calendar days after the 1st dose. In lieu of immunization, written evidence of laboratory tests showing immunity to Measles, Mumps, and Rubella is acceptable. MMR vaccine is not required for college students born before January 1957. Proof of Tetanus-Diphtheria (Td) booster **or** Tetanus-Diphtheria-Acellular Pertussis (Tdap) booster within last 10 years is also required. Other vaccines such as Meningococcal (meningitis), Varicella (chicken pox), and Hepatitis B are strongly recommended for college students. If immunization information is not on file, the Dean of Students and the Registrar may be notified. Please be aware that if there were to be an outbreak of a vaccine preventable infectious disease on campus (i.e. measles, mumps, chicken pox) you may need to be excluded from class if your records are not on file or if you lack immunity.

Health Sciences, Nursing, Physical Therapy, and Physician Assistant students may be required by their departments or programs to receive additional immunizations or documentation. Please contact your program for specific requirements.
