

# Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) Testing Options

## Carroll University Student Health Center

- ❖ Located in the lower level of New Hall, near the Oak room, x7233
- ❖ Confidential testing is available during our walk-in hours but student is charged per test, based on Waukesha Memorial Lab rates\*:
  - HIV \$25
  - Gonorrhea \$30
  - Chlamydia \$30
  - Both Gonorrhea & Chlamydia \$45
  - RPR (blood test for Syphilis) \$7 (Plus \$5 blood draw fee)
  - Herpes (of visible lesion) \$94
  - Herpes blood test \$50 (Plus \$5 blood draw fee)
  - Pregnancy \$5 (Done in Health Center with results in minutes)
  - Trichomoniasis \$5 (Plus \$15 visit charge in Health Center)
  - Genital warts (Covered under \$15 visit charge in Health Center)

- ❖ Full Service Sexually Transmitted Disease and HIV (STD / HIV) Clinic
  - Confidential counseling, testing and treatment for \$35
  - Every Tuesday (appointments available from 4:20 – 6:20 PM)
  - Appointments are required; call (262) 896-8450 to schedule appointment
- ❖ Chlamydia & Gonorrhea Screenings
  - Screenings only \$17
  - No Appointment Required, Available Any Day from 8 AM — 4 PM

## Planned Parenthood of Waukesha:

- ❖ 426 W. Main St. (262) 544-0708
  - Offers confidential testing with sliding scale fees based upon student's income level
  - Hours: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 11AM – 8PM, Wednesday 11AM – 5PM, Friday 9AM – 5PM, Saturday 10AM – 2PM
  - For STI testing- students with symptoms of STI are encouraged to schedule an appointment. Students without symptoms of STI can walk in without an appointment. No appointment is required for emergency contraception or birth control visits/refills.
