Registering to vote is easy in Wisconsin, and we have **3** ways to do it:

- 1. If you are from Wisconsin**, register online at MyVote.WI.gov. You can register online until **October 14th**. Most people use a Wisconsin driver's license, State ID, or Passport. The website will give you all the options. If you have to change your address it will help you do that.
- 2. If you are not from Wisconsin** but want to vote here you need the voter version of the Carroll ID which you can get from the Campus Center Info Desk. Register through the mail with instructions from MyVote.WI.gov. or call the city of Waukesha Clerk at 262-524-3550. (City Hall is closed because of construction, but they will still help you register.) Your mail-in registration must be postmarked by **October 14th**. You can also vote absentee from your family home.
- 3. If you didn't register early** you can register **on the day of the election** at your polling place. There will be student volunteers there to help you and the poll workers are friendly. You will need your Wisconsin ID and proof of residence if you are from Wisconsin, or the Carroll Voter ID, proof of enrollment, and proof of residence if you are from another state.
