

2021 Outstanding Senior Award Nomination Form

The Outstanding Senior award is given to an exceptional senior at Carroll University. Graduates from December 2019 may be considered for nomination. Faculty and staff members may nominate as many students as they feel have met some or all of the criteria in the areas listed below. Completed nominations should be submitted to eshort@carrollu.edu by **Thursday, April 1, 2021**.

The recognized student will have exhibited commitment to excellence in the following categories:

- **Campus Engagement** (Active member of student organizations including Student Senate)
- **Community Engagement** (Volunteer work experience)
- **Student Leadership** (Examples include - RA, OM, Admissions/Alumni Ambassador, etc.)
- **Any Additional Training/Experience** (Examples include - Attended conferences, Alternative Spring Break Trips, Academic collaborations, etc.)

Nominations for students should be no longer than one page in length (size 12, Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins). Please use specific campus and community engagement, student leadership, and any additional training/experience when describing why your nominee should be considered for the 2021 Outstanding Senior award.

A committee of Carroll University members will review the nominations and submit the winning name to the Pioneer Honors and Awards Ceremony committee. You will be notified if your nominee has been chosen and the winner will be announced at the Pioneer Honors and Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, April 28, 2021.
